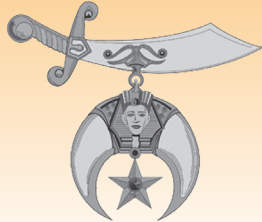

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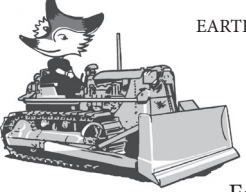

Parade Marshall David Roose has contacted all about these requirements. Often, Parade sponsoring committees will require the Certificate of Liability Insurance Coverage" before allowing us to parade.

The same caution goes to all Clubs and Units about any "Gaming" event. We MUST complete forms for permission and apply to the Indiana State Gaming Commission to hold a "gaming" event. Those forms are in the weekly communication as well.

A LIFELONG IMPACT

Burn survivor praises the SCO team for life-changing care



"I don't know what would have happened to me if I didn't end up at Shriners Children's."

That's a powerful testimony from former patient, Chris, who sustained a critical burn injury in a car accident in 1997 when he was a teenager in southern Illinois. He spent a few days at a hospital in his hometown until a distant family member mentioned Shriners Children's Ohio.

He was then transferred to our hospital (then located in Cincinnati) for extensive care. Chris said he still remembers connecting with other patients.

Shriners Children's Chicago honors impact of ENT docs

Patients and families appreciate our ear, nose and throat (ENT) physicians in the craniofacial/cleft program at Shriners Children's Chicago. We celebrated them during Kids ENT Month in February. We have 5 ENTs who evaluate patients to address concerns which might include a child sleeping well or having issues with clogged ears, which are more common in children with clefts.



Having ENTs on staff is part of Shriners Children's multidisciplinary approach to treating our young and mighty patients. ENTs

like Kathryn Colman, M.D. who work in our Thursday cleft 'team day', will also surgically place ear tubes, and can remove tonsils and evaluate adenoids if there are issues related to cleft/craniofacial conditions.

By the way, has anyone noticed the grass is growing! Time to go mow.

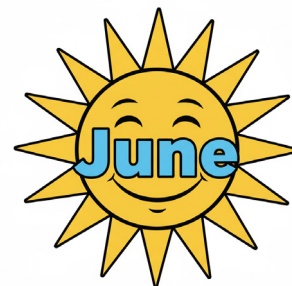
