Shriners Hospitals for Children in **Chicago** and **Cincinnati** have been collecting pull-tabs or "pop-tops" from beverage cans for more than 16 years, recycling them, and putting the money toward programs that directly benefit children. Since its inception, about a half-million pounds of aluminum tabs have been collected and recycled.

Did you know: The tabs are the only pure aluminum part of the can, and the cans may still be returned for deposit even after the tabs are removed.

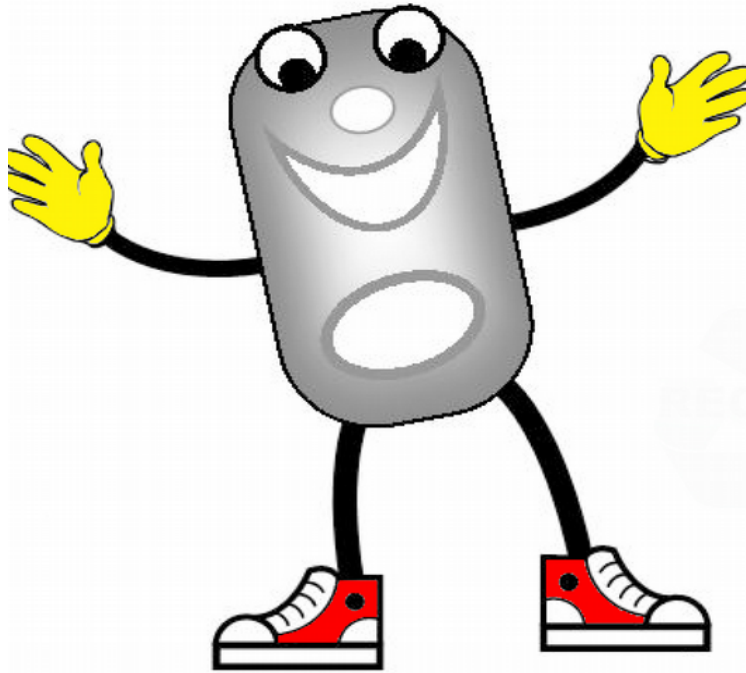

Rules

The club or unit with the most collected will be selected to send representatives to the Chicago Hospital to deliver them in person.

The contest runs from December 1, 2017 to March 1, 2019.

All pop tabs should be collected in a gallon milk jug with the club or unit name written on the outside of the milk jug with a lid on it. The milk jugs can be brought to the Mizpah Temple. They will be weighed and totals kept in office.

The club or unit with the most collected and turned in every quarter will be recognized and awarded a prize.

The grand prize will be presented at the April stated meeting in 2019.
